

3DBODY.TECH 2021 - INFORMATION AND DETAILS FOR ONSITE EXHIBITORS

1. VENUE, ADDRESS, PARKING, LOADING DOCK

The venue of the conference and exhibition is the Lugano Convention Center - Palazzo dei Congressi. Address:

A large parking is available just under the convention center for cars and vans with maximal height of 2.2m. Parking day tickets will be available at the welcome desk for the price of 20CHF. More detailed information about Lugano, access and travel are available at the following link:

The conference and exhibition will take place at the first floor (level +1) of the convention center. The exhibition will take place in the Room B2/3.

For unloading equipment and material, vehicles may be parked on the square in front of the convention center, the main entrance with a normal elevator or the loading dock with freight elevator may be used. The dimensions of the freight elevator are:

1.49m wide, 2.14m deep, 2.15m height; the doors are 1.2m wide, 2m height.


For large equipment/material: please plan accordingly the packing of your equipment/material so that everything can fit in the freight elevator. If required, we suggest to use multiple separate packages/boxes.

The congress center does not have transportation carts/pallet jacks/fork lifts.

For large equipment/material to be unloaded from trucks and loaded back: forks lifts and/or pallet jacks should be ideally arranged and organized by your transportation service. In special cases, we may use rental services for such equipment. In such cases, please contact us in advance.



Small boxes may find storage place at the exhibition room, whereas large boxes/cranes/etc. should be stored a storage room and/or storage space with a fixed fee of 50CHF per cubic meter.



2. INFRASTRUCTURE FOR EXHIBITORS

The week before the conference you will receive the final plan of the exhibition with the assigned spaces. The exhibition area will be naked, uniquely tables (170x85cm h74cm), chairs and electric plug will be provided. Please bring with you all the other required equipment and material.

Please remind that only a single electric plug (Swiss 3-poles, Type J, 250V 10A) will be available. You should bring with you the required electric cable extensions, multiplexers and adapters for the Swiss 3-poles plug (<u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/SN_441011</u>).

Note: the convention center does not allow signs or materials to be affixed to the walls, columns or doors.

Internet: a dedicated closed WiFi connection will be provided to all exhibitors (an open connection will be available for all attendees).

Additional infrastructure will be available upon request and has to be ordered in advance.

Please contact us in case you wish to order one of the following items:

- Special electric power connections
- Wired LAN Internet, cost 100 CHF (Swiss francs)
- Panels 1.2x2m, cost 150 CHF (Swiss francs)
- High tables, cost 30CHF (Swiss francs), high chairs, cost 25CHF (Swiss francs)
- TV/Monitor 65", with floor stand/support, installation included, cost approx 750 CHF (Swiss francs)

3. SETTING UP AND TEAR DOWN OF EXHIBITION

The time for setting up the exhibition is: Monday 18th October, from 12:00 until 18:00 (later if required). The exhibition will end on Wednesday 20th Oct., at 16:00. Time for dismount until 19:00 (later if required).

Incoming/outgoing of material/equipment (details see next section):

- incoming: Monday 18th October

- outgoing: Wednesday 20th October after 17:00.

4. INCOMING/OUTGOING MATERIAL/EQUIPMENT

Due to limited personnel and storage space, it is **not recommended** to deliver material/equipment before the set-up day of the exhibition (Mon. 18 Oct.) and to keep stored items/equipment after the conference. This would be possible uniquely as exception, please contact us or the convention center in such cases.

Please mention the conference name 3DBodyTech.

Please be advised that all shipment costs, customs and import taxes have to be paid prior to delivery, the venue will not accept any C.O.D. (Collect on Delivery) shipment.

For receiving material/equipment during the set-up day of the exhibition Monday 18th October and for sending material/equipment after the end of the exhibition on Wednesday 20th, it is strongly recommended that a responsible person will be present at the venue at the moment of arrival and departure of the items/equipment in order to avoid problems with documents/carnets/etc.. Please organize accordingly the arrival and departure of your items/equipment and provide the carrier with a mobile phone where you can be reached at the venue.

Please consider the terms for import/export (import taxes, VTA, etc.) for your material/equipment. Please note that Switzerland is part of the Schengen area but is not part of European Union.

ATA Carnet:

we strongly recommend all exhibitors to apply for a ATA Carnet. The ATA Carnet is an international customs and temporary import-export document, which simplify the customs procedures.

5. RESPONSIBILITY AT THE CONFERENCE VENUE

The exhibitor is fully responsible for the equipment/material exhibited at the venue. It is specifically understood that the exhibitor assumes responsibility and liability for any damage caused by its equipment/material.

The exhibition area will be open during all conference hours, coffee breaks and lunch breaks. It will be closed at the end of the day.

6. BADGES WITH QR CODE

The badges of all the participants of 3DBODY.TECH will have on the back side a QR code with the participant's contact details (VCARD Version 3). Please install a proper QR code reader on your mobile devices in order to scan the QR code and to collect digitally the contact details of participants. A sample QR code is imaged here below, it will be printed with approx. 5x5cm size.

8. COVID-19 / COVID CERTIFICATE / TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

To comply with the regulations introduced by the Swiss Government, a valid <u>COVID-19 certificate (vaccination</u> <u>certificate or proof of a negative test or proof recovery) is required</u> in order to access the Lugano convention center and attend 3DBODY.TECH 2021 onsite.

The European certificates (EU Digital Covid Certificate) and the Swiss certificates (Covid certificate), with their QR code on mobile devices or on paper, are directly recognized by the scanners at the convention center. If you have another type of certificate, you will need the same documentation required by entering Switzerland (see below).

All non-Swiss resident participants at 3DBODY.TECH 2021, can use the same COVID-19 certificate and/or documentation used to enter Switzerland in order to access the Lugano convention center. In detail, at least <u>one of the following certificate</u> is required:

- Vaccination proof with vaccines recognized by the Swiss government (Pfizer/BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Covishield, Jansen/Johnson&Johnson, Sinopharm/BIBP, Sinovac); the vaccination proof must contain surname, first name, date of birth, date and place of vaccination and the vaccine used.
- COVID-19 recovery certificate issued at most 6 month before arrival.
- Negative COVID-19 PCR or RT-PCR test taken at most 72 hours before arrival.
- Negative COVID-19 rapid antigen test taken at most 48 hours before arrival.

9. ONLINE CONFERENCE PLATFORM

The 3DBODY.TECH 2021 online conference platform is accessible to all onsite and online attendees, speakers, exhibitors.

The online conference platform allows to access live streams, recorded contents, group discussions and to use tools for networking with other online and onsite attendees, speakers, exhibitors.

Please note that **only registered participants** can access the online conference platform and actively communicate with other participants with messaging, chat, 1-to-1 video calls. The different exhibitor packages include at least **1 full registration**, which gives access also to the online conference platform. Please note that staff registrations do not have access to the online conference platform. Please contact us if additional registrations are required.

Details for accessing the online conference platform will be sent by email after your registration is confirmed. The online conference platform will be be accessible from **18 Oct. 2021**.

10. COMPANY AND PARTICIPANTS PROFILES ON THE ONLINE PLATFORM

You will receive separate links to edit/update the profiles of your company and your registered participants. These can be edited/updated already now, before the online conference platform is accessible. These can also be edited/updated inside the online conference platform as soon as it is accessible.

Each **registered participants** will receive an individual email with an individual link to edit/update the profile. The email address provided in the registration form will be used to identify each participant.

The following details can be edited/updated/added to your **participant profile**:

- Personal information: picture, biography, contact, socials
- Documents, external links
- Preferences/settings (only inside the online conference platform)

You will also receive an email with an individual link to edit/update the **company profile**. We have already added some basic information to your company profile, as it is stated on our website. You are free to change/update all the information and details.

The following contents can be edited/updated/added to your company profile:

- 1. Company name, email, description, logo
- 2. A single video: a video URL has to be provided (e.g. vimeo, Youtube)
- 3. A call-to-action button: text and a URL has to be provided
- 4. Contact details and social media
- 5. Documents: doc, ppt, pdf, jpg, png, maximal size 20MB
- 6. List of external links

Please contact us, if you have not received the emails with the links for editing/updating the profiles.

11. ONSITE PRESENTATION AT TECHNICAL SESSION

All the onsite exhibitor packages includes at least one onsite presentation at a technical session.

Presentation slots are attributed to exhibitors based on FCFS policy and upon availability in the program. We have scheduled presentations in selected technical sessions based on the topic of the presentation.

We need to receive from you for each presentation the following information and data:

- 1. The presentation title and if possible a summary/abstract
- 2. Name of the speaker/presenter (note: he/she has to be a registered participants)
- 3. Filled and signed consent and release form

Please do send to us all these until 30 Sept. 2021.

12. SCHEDULED LIVE-STREAM DEMONSTRATIONS FROM THE EXHIBITION FLOOR

In order to show the exhibition to online participants, live-stream demonstrations will be scheduled for each onsite exhibitor separately. A video crew will go to the exhibitor at the scheduled time, record and live stream the demonstration/presentation onto the online conference platform.

Live-stream sessions are attributed to exhibitors based on FCFS policy and upon availability in the program.

Please inform us if you wish to make changes or to cancel your scheduled live-stream session.

Notes: We will upload the recording onto the online conference platform, so that attendees can re-watch it later. The platform will be available with all recorded contents for 30 days after the conference.

13. SCHEDULED LIVE-STREAM SESSION FROM YOUR HQS/OFFICES

Alternatively to the live-stream demonstration from the exhibition floor, you can opt for a live-stream session from our HQs/offices.

Each exhibitor live-stream session is **30 minutes long** and **self-managed** by the exhibitor. It can be ideally used for **live demonstrations from your offices**, showcasing your products, solutions, e.g. 3D/4D body/face/foot scanners, processing software, application software, use cases, etc. The session will be live streamed onto the online conference platform, as well projected on a large screen on the onsite exhibition room. In this way, both online and onsite attendees can watch it live and post comments/questions.

Live-stream session set-up (with details for Zoom Pro):

You are free to use your preferred live stream method and provider. We recommend to use Zoom Pro (1 standard Pro license), as we are sure that it works well in the platform.

We will provide the 3 details needed for streaming live onto the platform: Stream URL, Key, Page URL.

In Zoom Pro you can setup the live stream by "Using a Custom Service" with the 3 data we will provide you. A guide is available at the following link:

At the scheduled day and time, you can start the live stream in Zoom and begin your live demonstration.

Important: you will **NOT need to invite participants** to join your Zoom session, attendees will see the session directly on the online conference platform.

Please do **record your live session** (Zoom offer this possibility) and send us a copy of the video (mp4) or provide us with a video url (e.g. vimeo, YouTube). We will upload the recording onto the online conference platform, so that attendees can re-watch it later. Note: the platform will be available with all recorded contents for 30 days after the conference.

13. SUGGESTIONS

We suggest the exhibitors to be very active also within the online conference platform in order to attract attention of the online attendees: participate at live chats during live sessions, participate at group discussions, post in the activity feed.
